## About this activity

Leading your own dog-sled team through a winding snowcovered forest is the experience of a lifetime. A one-of-akind Jackson Hole experience, learn how to "mush" with trained Alaskan sled dogs or relax in the sled while gliding through the valley. Several guided tours and vendors are available, all of which cover some of the most beautiful terrain in the valley – like the Gros Ventre Range, Granite Hot Springs and the Continental Divide. Each outfitter offers a different kind of experience, from full day excursions to mineral hot springs to a quick accessible ride at the base of Teton Village there are plenty of options to fit your liking.

Things might look a little different this year, so here are a few things to keep in mind:

- This is one of the most popular and limited activities in the valley so plan ahead to ensure availability for your guided tour.
- Indoor services may be limited, so call ahead for information and prepare to spend more time outdoors.
- Wear warm clothes, bring a mask and make sure to dress in layers.
